Frequently Asked Questions and Answers:

1. How will I know if my registration has been accepted and I am in the course for sure?

We will contact you by phone if we do not meet the required minimum for the course. We will contact you to reschedule or return your fees. Thank you for your patience!

2. How will I know if a class has been cancelled because of bad weather or other emergency?

If a class must be cancelled because of inclement weather or other emergency, please check our website home page for cancellation notices. Notices will be posted at least one hour before class time.

3. Are other family members, including children, permitted to come to the training classes?

We encourage other family members to come to learn how to train the family pet. We ask that children who are not actually training in the training ring remain seated quietly and observe the class.

4. My puppy's (dog's) shot records will not be complete until a few days before the course begins. What should I do in regard to making sure that CCDTC has these records on time?

If at all possible, please include shot records with your registration materials. If you need to mail them at a later date, please do so. If you are concerned about whether your shot records will be received on time, please contact the registrar to make other arrangements.

5. I am concerned that my puppy (dog) may be "aggressive" - should I consider a training course if this is the case?

First of all, it is important to determine whether or not your dog is indeed "aggressive". Please call the club voicemail at 513-625-4337 with your question or contact the registrar for suggestions.

6. If I am unable to attend a class, what should I do?

Let your instructor know beforehand if possible so that s(he) can tell you about the next class. Your instructor will also provide a phone number to call for class homework, etc.
