

COVID-19 safety measures that CCDTC has in place:

Per the current Ohio COVID regulations, masks are no longer required for CCDTC Classes. BUT an instructor may ask that the students in his/her class wear them. It will be noted on the class description page.

Classes will go back to a maximum of 8 students.

Adult family members may watch classes, but please do not bring any children unless the child is the dog's handler.

In case you are exposed to, or contract COVID-19, following is the protocol

COVID-19 Exposure

Any student, instructor, member, competitor at an event or service provider exposed to COVID-19 must quarantine away from the building for 14 days.

For students: any remaining classes will be pro-rated and applied to the next available class similar in scope and equivalent in price.

COVID-19 Positive Test

Any student, instructor, member, competitor at an event or service provider testing positive for Covid-19 must quarantine away from the building for 14 days, or 10 days following a positive test or symptoms first appeared AND no fever for 24 hours (without using medication).

For students: any remaining classes will be pro-rated and applied to the next available class similar in scope and equivalent in price.

Who to Notify

Students and instructors should notify the training director (td.ccdtc@gmail.com) as soon as possible of their issues. The Training Director will notify the board

Competitors: Notify event chair as soon as you receive a Positive test

Service providers should notify their club contact person.

CCDTC Reporting of incident

CCDTC will post on their FB page of any possible exposures at an event

CCDTC will notify students and members of a possible exposure at a class
