

Key Worker Job Descriptions

Seminars:

In the past, the chair received no "Incentives." Chairing a seminar is to educate the dog loving public.

There is a need for anywhere from 4 to 8 workers at seminars-the number of hours varies, they may do multiple jobs

Most presenters accept that the club workers are there as auditors and there is no charge for them. They have jobs that require bouncing in and out of the seminar = not getting everything that is presented/taught/etc.

There may be kitchen workers who come to help in the kitchen, but do not audit-they are allowed to count those hours as worker hours. They do not stay for the seminar.

Worker Buck Policy: Key workers attend the seminar are free auditors- no worker bucks given in past.

Key Worker Policy:

Email sent out asking for help. Some key positions may be offered first to those who have done the job or asked to be worked in the past.

Key Workers Listed / Job Descriptions / hours worked:

Check in person 2 hrs in am- help in other needed areas through out the day
Product sales person-about 6 hrs each day-some presenters have no product to sell
Helping people get settled person-two to three hours a day-help in other needed areas through out the day

Kitchen chair usual duties- purchase food, prep breakfast, prep and serve lunch, prep snacks, clean up and prep for next day as appropriate
2-4 helpers. Some may get worker hours/ bucks if they come to help and do not audit seminar.
